Fork biscuits

250g butter

125g caster sugar

300g self-raising flour

1. Beat the butter to soften it. Gradually beat in caster sugar.
2. Add flour and mix well.
3. Roll into small balls, place on a greased baking tray and flatten with a fork.
4. Bake at 180C for 15-20 minutes.
