



Spring Term: Home Learning Programme

Dear Parents/Carers,

We appreciate that many parents will be juggling your own remote working responsibilities with managing home learning for your children. We fully appreciate the challenges that this brings.

Following government recommendations, we are now asking you to aim for your child to spend a minimum of 3 hours per day on their home learning activities in KS1 and from 4 hours in KS2. Ideally, this would include phonics (in KS1), Maths, English (spelling, reading and writing) and one other subject-based activity per day in KS1 and two in KS2. This includes 2 hours of PE a week. If you can manage this, you are doing brilliantly!

Remote Learning: School Website and Microsoft Teams

In addition to your Home Learning Pack, if you are unable to access remote learning using Teams you should use the materials provided within your class portal on our website. In this case, you should maintain contact with your child’s class teacher, using the direct class email.

Microsoft Teams Reception Children

We have now set up your remote learning facility through Microsoft Teams. Your child’s login details will be sent to you directly, using your family registered email. For those parents already familiar with Microsoft Teams, please be aware that we will only be using the ‘posts’ and ‘files’ options, we will not be using the ‘meet now’ or live video options.

Daily Timetable:

The following is our Remote education timetable which we expect all of our home learners to follow.

Pupils have the opportunity to send messages (posts) to their class teacher, who is live at register times and will monitor and respond at periods during the day; whilst also teaching at school.
