

## Swimming results 2022

We take our swimming lessons in June/ July each year. This information will be updated after these sessions.

In June/ July 2020 all pools were closed due to Covid19 and in July 2021 we were only able to book 3 hours of swimming for the Year six group therefore our current Year 6 could not take part in annual swimming lessons in Year 4 or 5. This has had an impact on progress for some pupils.

Meeting national curriculum requirements for swimming and water safety. Please complete all of the below:

What percentage of your Year 6 pupils could swim competently, confidently and proficiently over a distance of at least 25 metres when they left your primary school?	78% could swim 25m at end of Y6  65% at confident, proficient level.
What percentage of your Year 6 pupils could use a range of strokes effectively [for example, front crawl, backstroke and breaststroke] when they left your primary school?	65%
What percentage of your Year 6 pupils could perform safe self-rescue in different water-based situations when they left your primary school?	83%
Schools can choose to use the Primary PE and Sport Premium to provide additional provision for swimming but this must be for activity over and above the national curriculum requirements. Have you used it in this way?	This year we have used some funding to provide an additional pool session for all y4-6 children and for CPD for new members of staff.
