PARENT GOVERNOR ELECTIONS

We have a brilliant opportunity on our Governing Body, which is available for someone who would like to support the school by becoming a Parent Governor.

Documentation in respect of this will be sent out early next week to all parents/careers and will contain a nomination form and details of the election process. Interested parents/careers who wish to become a Parent Governor are asked to fill in the nomination form and provide a personal statement to show how they met the strategic requirements. On receipt of the details the nomination form will be required to be returned within 10 days for consideration. If only one nomination is received, subject to meeting with Governors they will be elected as a parent Governor and attend the next Governors meeting subject to a full enhanced DBS check. If more than one nomination is received, there will then follow a secret ballot with papers issued to all parents/careers to vote. The person with the most votes will then be elected again following a meeting with Governors - Julie Bioletti Clerk to the Governors
