Free School Meal – Are you Eligible? From September 2026 the Department for Education is introducing new benefit criteria which will mean that all children from households in receipt of universal credit will be entitled to receive a free school meal. There will be two categories of benefits-based free school meals, known as 'Targeted FSM' and 'Expanded FSM'. Parent Governor Vacancy

"The School's Governing Board has a Vacancy for a Parent Governor and will be seeking nominations next week. A letter and nomination form will be sent out via Parent contact to all parents/careers on the 15th September (paper copies can be requested from the Admin Team). Nomination forms to be returned by noon on Tuesday 6th October either electronically or by handing a paper form to the Admin Team. All nominations to be marked confidential for the attention of the Clerk. If more than one nomination is received an election will be held the following week which all parent/careers are entitle to vote and details will follow if required.

The Governing Board is responsible for providing confident and strategic leadership, and creating robust accountability, oversight and assurance for the school's educational and financial performance. The role is largely a Strategic one, not an Operational one in the running of the day to day matters of the school. The Governing Board is passionate about education and committed to continuous school improvement to ensure the best possible outcomes for our pupils. Further details will be found in the letter being sent out.

The Governors look forward to receiving nominations for this role from Parents/careers from all Class years.

Year 6 Secondary Transfer 2027

Your child is due to transfer to secondary school in September 2027. The online application process opens on 1st September 2026 and closes on 31 October 2026. A letter will be sent

home with your child, outlining the process. Alternatively, please [Apply to start or transfer school | Shropshire Council](#) which takes you to the Shropshire Council Admissions Website. Details about secondary school open evenings can be found in the Parents' Guide to Secondary Education in Shropshire booklet on the same website.

Applications received by Shropshire Council after the closing date will be classed as late, which may result in your child being disadvantaged, so please ensure you make your application on-time. Late applications will not be processed until all on-time applications have been offered.

You can name up to four schools on your application – we encourage parents to make full use of these preferences. If only one preference is named, and we cannot offer this, we will have no choice on National Offer Day but to offer a place at the nearest school with a vacancy, which could be a considerable distance from your home address.
